University is conducting various courses/programs which are based on both Annual and Semester patterns, as prescribed by the related regulatory body.

Annual Pattern-

- At the end of every academic year Theory Examinations & Practical Examinations are conducted.
- During the academic year there is a pattern of 'continuous assessment' in order to evaluate student's academic performance continuously in a course.
- Depending upon the programme of continuous assessment is done, giving weightage as described in the Ordinance of the University in the total score of a particular course.
- Within six months of declaration of main examination results, a supplementary examination is conducted for those failed students to enable them to clear the arrear paper/subject.
- University follows absolute marking system for evaluation.
- The basic structure and content of each academic program is prescribed by the respective Board of Studies and approved by the Academic Council of the University.
- The Projects and Dissertations are evaluated by Boards of Examiners as stated in the Ordinances of the University and by the Regulatory bodies.

Semester Pattern-

- At the end of every Semester theory Examinations & Practical Examination are conducted.
- During the academic year there is a pattern of 'continuous assessment' in order to evaluate student's academic performance continuously in a course.
- Continuous assessment is given defined weightage as described in the Ordinance of the University in the total score of a particular course depending upon the program.
- Within six months of declaration of main examination results, examinations are conducted for those students who are declared as failed enabling them to clear the arrear paper/subject.
- University follows absolute marking system as well as grading system on 10 Point Scale.
- The basic structure of each academic program is determined by the respective Board of Studies and approved by the Academic Council of the University.
- The Projects and Dissertations are evaluated by Board of Examiners as stated in the Ordinances of the University and defined by the Regulatory bodies.

- 2) Examination committee shall recommend to the Controller of Examinations the name of examination, question paper setters, moderators and examiners of different subjects. Vice Chancellor will have the right to add or delete names in the proposed list.

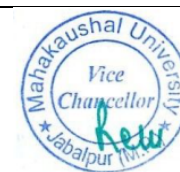
